Upon completion of our state review, I am pleased to inform you that the Maryland State Department of Education Division of Early Childhood Development will accept the "ProCPR" blended course (Initial and Recertification) in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED), as meeting the requirements for Basic Life Support certification course enrollment and state certification testing.

As we discussed, only the blended course will be accepted for both initial CPR and First Aid certification and recertification, the online course will not be accepted. Instructors and agencies will be able to identify the permanent blended course completion card from the online card because it will have the digital signatures of both the instructor and skill evaluator on the back.

ProCPR will be added to the current list of approved CPR providers and distributed to all Maryland child care licensing regions. They will begin accepting proof of the "blended program" only.
